## **Ownership & Disclosure Requirements**

Louisiana Healthcare Connections is in the process of updating our provider records and, as part of state and federal requirem ents, must obtain a current Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement (CMS-1513) from all contracted Bayou Health providers.

This information is requested at the time of credentialing/contracting as well as on a three-year cycle. Per federal law 42 CFR §§ 455.100-106, providers must disclose the following information:

- Individuals with Ownership and Control Interest
- Managing Employee Information
- Criminal Convictions of the Provider and Other Parties Associated with the Provider's Entity

Louisiana Healthcare Connections utilizes this information only for purposes of complying with the requirements of the State of Louisiana in conducting criminal and other background checks and complies with all federal and state privacy and security rules and regulations.

Who must complete the Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement form? Any provider who participates in or wishes to participate in our network including, but not limited to:

- Individual providers
- Hospitals
- Home Health Agencies
- Independent Clinical Laboratories
- Rural Health Clinics
- Federally Qualified Health Centers

To meet disclosure requirements, we must obtain completed and current Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement forms for both the medical entity and each provider affiliated with the entity whenever one of the following conditions applies:

- upon submission of a provider application,
- upon execution of the provider agreement, and
- within 35 days after any change in ownership of the contracted entity.

- EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2013: Your Provider Handbook and Billing Manual have merged! We have combined the provider handbook and billing manual into one comprehensive "Provider Manual." The updated version is posted on our website at www. LouisianaHealthConnect.com. To request a CD, please call Provider Services at 1-866-595-8133 and we will be happy to assist you.

- ▶ UPDATE: Place Of Service (POS) 11 Billing Code: Louisiana Healthcare Connections follows all Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) guidelines for receiving and processing all Medicaid claims. Current CMS guidelines mandate services

rendered and submitted by a Rural Health Clinic (RHC) be billed with a "POS Code 72" and services rendered and submitted by a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) be billed with a "POS Code 50."

Any claim submitted by an RHC or FQHC and billed with a "POS Code 11" *will be denied*. For questions or concerns regarding this update, please call Provider Services at **1-866-595-8133** and we will be happy to assist you.

CLAIM ADJUSTMENT: Modifier 25: As of September 28, 2013, Pediatricians, Family Practice, Internal Medicine and General Practice should no longer receive requests for medical records on claims billed with Modifier 25 for CPT Codes 99211, 99202 or 99212. ALL claims with Date Of Service from January 1, 2013-September 27, 2013 denied for medical records will be adjusted.


### A Message From Chief Medical Director Dr. David Thomas

The recent challenges in healthcare delivery are upon us and, as one of the providers in this state, I recognize and support the critical need for proactive intervention.

My number one goal is to remove the barriers between providers and the care of their patients by reducing administrative paperwork and error and, in order to expedite determinations and appeals, I have developed a flexible, peer-to-peer system for case review. As envisioned, it will incorporate a dedicated and direct "dictation line" on which providers can leave (up to five minutes) their case notes for our internal review. In addition, we will offer an online alternative for providers seeking a "person-to-person" case review. This application will feature multiple appointment times from which to choose and the functionality to link to calendars and smartphones for convenient reminders. I am excited to be launching this tool and welcome your feedback for ways to improve. Look for more information on "**CASE***Connect*" in the coming weeks.

Lastly, one of our ongoing challenges has been the management of our Pharmacy benefit relative to the Louisiana Healthcare Connections Preferred Drug List (PDL) and our PBM US Scripts. I recognize the issues surrounding approvals for many drugs used in every day practice and want to personally assure you we are working daily with our pharmacy department on behalf of you and your patients.
